

ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING: Wed Sept 18

Play starts Oct 1 & 2, and runs 10 weeks through Dec 3 and 11.

NOW IS THE TIME TO START ORGANIZING YOUR TEAM.

Each tavern is responsible for organizing their own team, and may establish any criteria they wish for participation on their team. Teams are a minimum of 8 and a maximum of 12 players.

The sponsor fee is \$75 per team, and all team members must be dues-paying members of C.O.D.

Each week 4 players from your team are home, and 4 away. Play runs for 10 weeks on either Tuesday or Wednesday night.

If you know of any playing sites that are interested in playing in this type of league, get in touch with them immediately and start planning a team.

TOURNAMENT PLAYERS GROUP

Geez... I wish I'd known about that tournament in Sitka Alaska, I was there last month. That \$6,000 shoot in Sheboogamoo was listed as July 5 on the ADO calendar, and it changed to July 12? What?, there was a small tourney in Roundtown last weekend, I didn't hear anything about it!

Ever had that situation happen to you? Want to be reminded of tournaments coming up? Want to know more about tournaments?

Join the TOURNAMENT PLAYERS GROUP!

We have had several requests for more and better distribution of tournament information, and for the small cost of \$5 per year, you can receive it directly.

The ADO tournament calendar is issued every January, and we get enough copies for almost all of our members, and distribute them via captains at the start of Winter Season. However, the details for this calendar are compiled in early Fall. Things change after that time. Prize purses are increased or decreased, dates are changed for some tourneys. There are a number of things that can be different by the time the date of the event nears.

(For example, our own Buckeye Open dates have been changed, and the purse increased since material went in for the ADO calendar last September.)


The Tournament Plyaers group will be a special mail information service for those who wish to get tournament information directly, in a timely fashion.

As we receive information and fliers about tournaments we will mail it to you directly. You will receive a copy of the ADO calendar directly, as well as each quarterly issue of the ADO Newsletter "The Double Eagle". We will do our best to get fliers and other information from tournament sponsors, and mail it to you directly.

We can't promise that we will be able to get details of all tournaments, but for those we do we will distribute it. The key here is that for the small cost of \$5 you can receive, at least monthly, the information we do have and get. If the tourney sponsor sends only 5 fliers, and we have 50 members in the Tournament Players Group, we'll make extra copies and send them to everyone.

If you are interested in this service, be sure to indicate that on your registration form, and include the additional \$5 when paying your dues and team fees for this fall. If you decide later to "join the group" we will have a system in place by Fall for yout to do so.

This is being run as a test this year to see if there is enough interest, and to evaluate costs.






