

ADO NEWS

What in the world is the ADO? It's the AMERICAN DARTS ORGANIZATION, the national organizing body for the Sport of Darts in the U.S.

Recognizing that Darts are organized, run and promoted on the local level, its purpose is to promote our sport nationally and internationally, without taking over control of local organizations. C.O.D. has been a member of ADO since its founding in 1976.

ADO divides the country into 6 Areas. The Area Managers and several other national level people serve on the ADO Board of Directors.

Each Area is divided into Regions. We are in Region IV-1 which covers So. Ohio, So. Indiana, & SW Pennsylvania. Regional Directors oversee the details of each.

The only person who gets any compensation for serving the ADO in any organizing capacity is the Executive Director, and that's only part-time. Everyone else is a volunteer!

The most immediate advantage you, as a C.O.D. member have from our membership in the ADO is the opportunity to participate in a series of National Playoffs for various nationwide and international competitions. Specifically, these are the Pacific Cup Team in even years, and yearly in the All-Star Playoffs and Winmau World Masters Teams.

Playoffs are at the Regional Level. From there you move to the National level.

The ADO also has a National Championship Points ranking system for tournament players. You receive National and Regional points based upon where you finish in singles events in ADO Sanctioned tournaments throughout the year. When you play in a tournament, and finish in the money, make sure you report that you are C.O.D. member.

Our own Coordinator, Charlie Forrester was recently elected Regional IV-1 Director for 1992-93.

This is our chance to take a shot at qualifying for the NATIONAL ADO ALL STAR

Each year the American Darts Organization has a nationwide tournament to decide the East and West All Star Teams. These 2 square off at the annual All Star Challenge in Las Vegas in mid-August.

As an ADO affiliate, C.O.D. is welcome to send representatives to the Regional Playoffs to be held in Columbus the weekend of June 5-7.

At least 1 man and 1 women from our qualifier will go to the Regional Playoffs. We will send an additional man for each 20 men entering, and an additional woman for each 20 women entering.

Each Region sends 1 man for every 8 men entered and 1 woman for every 8 women entered on to the EAST-WEST CHALLENGE in Las Vegas. If we have 16 men, then 2 from our region go. If we have 24 women, the 3 women get the trip.

The ADO picks up most of your expenses to Las Vegas, and you get a special All Star shirt. Most important of all, you get to play some of the top darters not only in our area, but from across the country!

The Nodor \$50,000 North American Open is also in Vegas that weekend!
