




If you are asked to help take tickets or registration, set up or clean up, please say "yes". If we all do a little, things can get accomplished quickly and easily.

Hey, Fellow Darters! How's everyone's summer? I hope everyone is enjoying the warm weather and, for those who are finished with the summer league, let's hope your darts were true to form.

In this article I thought I'd list the Blind draws around town. The most familiar blind draw and the longest running is the Wednesday Night Blind Draw held at the Drest Tavern. This draw opens at 7 and closes at 8 with an entry fee of \$3.00. The COD runs this tourney and takes entries by phone. Payback is 100% of entry fees. The Crest also hosts a blind draw on Sunday which starts at the same times.

The next blind draw is Friday night, and will be run by the East Side Dart League. They are re-starting a very popular Friday night blind draw at a different location. It will start August 22 and be held at Mike Capoziello's new bar called Capoziello's Restaurant and Sports Lounge, located at 4333 S. Hamilton Rd. Registration opens at 7 and closes at 8 sharp.

Entry fee is \$3 with an 80% payback. The ESDL will also feature a point award along with the payback to the top 4. At the end of October, the person with the most points will receive accommodations and entry fees at the Buckeye Open.

Welcome back to the blind draw circuit, ESDL.

The last blind draw is the newest and will be held on Saturday nights at Sawmill Lanes. Registration opens at 7 and closes at 7:45, with play starting at 8 pm. Entry fee is \$3 with 100% payback. Sawmill Lanes is also paying \$20 to the first T80 hit each night. If there are none hit, then \$20 will be added each week until someone hits it. Phone registrations are welcomed. Ask for Liz or A.W. This blind draw will start up August 16 and be held in the lounge which features specials on all flavors of Schnapps for the summer.

Till next issue, this is the Pub Prowler saying, "In the heat of competition, good sportsmanship always comes first."



# NEW COD REGISTRAR



The COD Board of Directors at their August 6 meeting elected a new League Registrar. Greg Smith a three year COD member will tackle this very important position, replacing Mike Carney who filled this spot during the 1985-86 COD year. Greg played winter season with the North End Nads in B Division.

The position of League Registrar is the hub around which the whole COD revolves. The task of assigning 120+ teams to 60+ boards in 25+ bars is often taken for granted by all league members, except for those most closely involved.

In the past COD Registrars have often been frustrated by lack of cooperation in this demanding job. Greg hopes this will change as he takes on this job. If all members will make a point to fill out all registration forms "completely" and complete score cards in full, Greg's job will be that much easier.

### REGISTER FOR FALL SEASON

Let's help make Greg's job a little easier by doing the following to register for Fall Season:

- 1. Get your teams organized!
- Get your sponsors!
- Neatly, accurately, and COMPLETELY fill out the registration form.
- Mail it before August 21st or bring it along with all fees (checks only no cash) to the End of Season Party on August 23rd.

You don't need a team to join the COD. It's O.K. to sign up as a sub or ask to be put on a team.

### WHO ME? READ DART NEWSLETTERS?

SURE YOU DO! WE ALL DO. It always has something in it for any of us. If nothing else, where can you find out about parties? Or catch the Pub Prowler?

### WHO ME? READ STANDING SHEETS?

Every Monday nite. All season long. It's the only place to find out how you and your team stand against the rest of the league. Plus it's always great to see your name in print on the honors sheet.

### WHO ME? HELP WITH THE PAPERWORK?

To miss seeing your name when you've got some ink coming is always a drag. Since the registrar is only human it's to everyone's advantage to take some simple steps to ease the load.

- Step 1. Make sure the scorecards are filled out neatly (no heiroglyphics) with everyone's number by their names. Since I don't know all 600+ darters personally yet this makes sure the honors are recorded properly. Yes you're tied to a number in the computer ... stupid machine.
- Step 2. Make sure the card doesn't get lost on the captains dashboard.
- Step 3. If you know anyone who isn't geting their newsletters, etc., it's because we don't have their address in our files. Drop off the info at the Crest and I'll take care of it.
- Step 4. Send in any suggestions that can improve the standing sheets and help make them more interesting!
