We'll start out with a "fun" event for all of you who wish you could play on the PGA Tour. THE C.O.D. GOLF-DART OPEN!



A dart off the scoring surface is a Double-Bogey (+2). If you throw your 3rd dart. it is the one that counts, regardless of the previous 2 darts score. Your best for the 3 darts is your score for that "hole". If tied after 18, sudden death on 19, 20, 1, etc.

Your Board of Directors has been busy this Spring. Over the course of several Board and Committee meeting in May and June, some important business has been taken care of

James Kinney is now the Vice President and Mike Lewis will serve as Treasurer. Charlie Forrester agreed to serve as Secretary to the Board.

The BUCKEYE OPEN purse was increased to \$10,000 with the addition of a Ladies Singles event on Friday night. The ALL-STAR TEAM qualification format was completely revamped into what we feel will result in a fairer system, and at the same time build the best team for the QUAD-CITY CHALLENGE.

A new scheduling system for Monday Night has been adopted, as well as a new match format for Gold Flight.

There are numerous other details that must be taken care of in order to keep an organization like ours running smoothly. Your Board has spent a lot of time both individually and as a group seeing to them.

NEW

QUAD-CITY ALL-STAR QUALIFICATIONS

Qualifying competition starts in early September for the CENTRAL OHIO ALL-STAR TEAM. Here's your chance to play in what has developed into one of the most spirited and fun dart competitions in the country, the QUAD-CITY CHALLENGE!

Each year All-Star teams from Cincinnati, Cleveland, Columbus and Dayton square off for bragging rights as the best dart city in the State. Our team of 28 men and 14 women will be chosen from throughout Central Ohio in a series of qualifiers to be held in September and October.

There are 2 rounds, Preliminary and Round-Robin Finals. You must compete in the Preliminaries to qualify for the Round-Robin Finals. Here's how it works. (All games are 501 S-I/D-O.)

PRELIMINARY ROUND:

Each person will throw a minimum of 9 games and can throw as many as 36 games. Each game will cost you \$1. Games must be thrown in groups of 3 at-a-time. You will be paired with an opponent for each 3-game set.

Your average number of darts for ALL games thrown in the Preliminary Round will be your score. The top 48 men and 24 women from the Preliminary Round will qualify for the Round-Robin Finals.

ALL GAMES COUNT FOR SCORE! In other words, once you start a set of 3 games, you must complete all 3 games of that set. There will be no "scratches". Failure to complete a Preliminary Round 3-game set will result in a penalty of 225 darts being assessed against your score.

ROUND-ROBIN FINALS:

This will be a seeded round-robin tourney. Seeding will be based on your Preliminary Round score. Men will be in 6 groups of 8, women in 4 groups of 6. You will play 3 games against each person in your group, one point for each win. The top 3 men from each group (18) and top 2 women from each group (8) will make the team. (Ties will be played off.)

If you aren't successful in qualifying for the team in the first Round-Robin, or couldn't compete for some reason, YOU STILL HAVE A SECOND CHANCE! This will be a round-robin tourney too. Men will play 5 groups of 6, women 2 groups of 8. The top 2 men from each group (10) and top 3 women from each group (6) will round out the team. Again, it will be 3 games against each opponent, one point per win, and ties will be played off. Groupings will be by blind draw.

Our regular Wednesday Night Blind Draw will be something special on Aug 19.


We will once again honor Bill Dupler, long-time owner of the Crest Tavern, and friend of C.O.D.


PERFECT OUT SHOTS!

FALL SCHEDULE AND FORMAT CHANGES

SCHEDULE

This Fall Season will see a new scheduling system for our Monday Night League.

We will schedule 6 teams per division, The season will run 12 weeks. You will play each team in your division twice (weeks 1-5 and weeks 7-11). Weeks 6 and 12 will be "position rounds". The 1st place team plays the 2nd place team, 3rd plays 4th, and 5th plays the 6th place team.


Flight Playoffs will return to Monday Night, and be the 13th week. Our "15th Week Singles" tourney will be week 14.

We have been considering several options for a new schedule. We believe this will prove to be the best. Statistically there is more parity between groups of 6 teams than groups of 8. The "position rounds" should make each division more competitive and keep more teams in the hunt for 1st or 2nd place throughout the season.

We plan to return to including all divisions in Flights. There won't be a separate Flight for one division like this past Winter Season.

Our test with a 6-team division last season worked well. However, there aren't enough weeks in the Fall to have everyone play each team 3 times between Labor Day and Christmas.

We have adopted this new schedule for the Fall Season only at this point. We will evaluate it throughout the season, and make plans for Winter Season accordingly.



MATCH FORMAT

This Fall Season will also see a change in our match format for some teams.

"A" Division will continue to play 501 S-I/D-O and Cricket, with all of their games best-of-3, except 801 Team.


The other divisions in Gold Flight will change to 501 S-I/D-O Singles and Doubles, and 801 S-I/D-O Team Game, along with Cricket Singles and Doubles.

Singles and Team will remain 1 game and Doubles will remain best-of-3.

All other Divisions and Flights will continue to play 301 D-I/D-O Singles, 501 D-I/D-O Doubles, Cricket Singles and Doubles, and 801 D-I/D-O Team, 1 game of each.

As with the schedule change, we will evaluate this new format for Gold Flight during the season and make plans for the Winter Season accordingly.

Your Board of directors believes these scheduling and format changes will be positive and a lot of fun for all of our members. We welcome your input as the season progresses.

NOW is the time to tell everyone you know that ALL TEAM REGISTRATIONS FOR FALL SEASON MUST BE IN BY AUGUST 8!!!

You can mail them. You can place them in the C.O.D. Drop-Box at the Crest. You can deliver them by Pony Express, UPS, or private courier, we'll take 'em any way you can get 'em to us. However, WE'VE GOT TO HAVE THEM BY AUGUST 8!!!

Some important things to remember:

- We've got to have your Membership Dues and Team Fees with your Registration. Everyone "expires" at the end of August, so each person playing this Fall has to renew their membership and dues of \$25. (Checks or Money Orders only, please. NO CASH!)
- If you are sponsored: Have your sponsor check with you or pay with your own and get reimbursed by your sponsor. (We'll give you a receipt.)
- 3. We up-date our mailing list at this time. Yeah, we know, Ralph hasn't moved since World War II. Maybe we've got something wrong with his address or maybe he changed jobs and his phone is wrong. Please list all vital information. (Captains, we MUST have a phone number for you.)
- 4. You can have anybody you want on your team, as long as you sign them up as a member of your team by AUGUST 8. The only restriction is:
 "A player or substitute may not become a registered member of a team after the registration deadline if within the previous 2 years he/she was a registered member of a team that played in a division that was at least 4 divisions higher."

TEAM SPONSORSHIP

A POSITION STATEMENT
Adopted by Board of Directors Oct 1989

The C.O.D. Board of Directors does not wish to encourage or discourage sponsorship of teams or members playing in its leagues. Sponsorship arrangements should be left solely to the discretion of the parties involved.

However, the Board does feel very strongly that a team or member seeking sponsorship has an obligation to fully explain to the potential sponsor exactly what they are being asked to pay for.


Specifically, this relates to membership dues. Since your dues makes you a member of C.O.D. for the full year (or remaining part), regardless of whether you play during a given league or season, your potential sponsor should be made aware of this fact, if you are asking them to pay your membership dues

The Board hereby goes on record as not endorsing sponsors paying individual member dues as part of a sponsorship arrangement. It feels that individual members should pay their own dues. At the same time, this does not prohibit sponsors from paying individual member dues if they so wish.

The Board has received comments and complaints that \$200 (5 people, dues & teams fees) is a lot to pay to sponsor a team. It does not wish to hear such comments/complaints in the future.

Future or continued abuse of your obligation to fully explain to a potential sponsor exactly what they are paying for may result in a sponsorship disclosure statement having to be signed by sponsors. That's just another unnecessary bureaucratic step that none of the want. Let's all be fair and up front with those who sponsor teams!


