The chances that Tiger Woods will be there are slim and none, but we can guarantee DRY conditions at the 6th annual C.O.D. GOLF-DART OPEN!

That's right, what the Memorial can't provide C.O.D can guarantee, at the Grotto on August 16 for this FUN event.

There's no cost for admission! The Greens Fees are cheap! You won't need a cart! In fact, we'll even throw in the food and liquid refreshments so necessary to quench that parched pallet and hearty appetite brought on by a long day on the links.

The rules are simple. You play up to 3 darts at each number 1 thru 18, in order. A Single is Par (even), a Triple's a Birdie (-1) and a Double's an Eagle (-2). Miss the number and it's a Bogey (+1). The last dart thrown is your score. That's right, you can stop after 1 or 2 and take that score if you like. However, land outside the Double ring with any dart, and you score a Double Bogey (+2), and can't throw any more that turn.

Everyone will play 2 rounds (36 "holes"). We'll then have a "Cut" to the top 1/2 (plus ties). Scores for the first 2 rounds will be voided, and these survivors will play 2 more rounds. If there's a tie after the next 36 "holes", there will be a sudden death playoff on 19, 20, 1, etc. to determine the winner and places.

Can you think of a better way to spend a hot, humid August day than in the air conditioned comfort of the Grotto in the company of dart players? We'll have the usual assortment of delicious stuff to eat, as well as appropriate liquid refreshments throughout the day.

As always, this party is free to all current C.O.D. members and this time your adult guests are on us! Please remember, darts is an adult sport and this is an adult party.

1997 ALL-STAR TEAM

Want to play darts against some of the best players around? Want to be on the most prestigious dart team you can think of? Want to help bring the Quad-City Challenge trophy to Columbus for the first time?

Want to have FUN?

Then you should be on the...

1997 CENTRAL OHIO ALL-STAR TEAM! and play in the Quad-City Challenge!

The Sunday before Thanksgiving is YOUR-opportunity to play agianst the best from Cincinnati, Cleveland and Dayton in what is probably the most FUN 1-day darting event in the country.

Picture over 200 people all in one room playing or watching our favorite sport. Picture the thrill you'll get when our team takes first place. Picture the honor you'll feel when the Quad-City trophy comes to Columbus for the first time ever!

In our on-going effort to assemble the best team possible... we have again chaged the format. One that will give us the most competitive team possible.

Here are the details:

First, we decided to offer 14 men and 3 women-AUTOMATIC berths on the team. Each "Position" may be challenged by anyone a maximum of 5 times. Format is 501 SI/DO best-of-5. That takes place on Saturday July 26 from 3:00 to 6:00 at the Crest Tavern. Cost is \$5 per position you wish to challenge, and its first come-first serve.

There are 16 more spots for men and 12 more for women on the team. Those spots will be filled through an Open qualifying process. Men will play 4 and women 3 games of 501 SI/DO total darts counted. You can take as many shots at this as you want, it will cost you \$5 for each attempt. There are 4 scheduled dates for this qualifying step.

Based upon this qualifying step, 32 men and 32 women will qualify for a Double-Elimination Tournament. The top-8 men and women will be on the team. (We now have 22 men & 11 women.)

Don't worry, there's a Second Chance shot at making the team!

The 24 men and 24 women who didn't make the team via the first Double-Elimination will be automatically entered in a 2nd Chance D/E tourney, along with the next 8 ranked players from the open qualifying. The top-8 men and top-4 women from that event will round out the team. (That's a total of 30 men and 15 women making up the team.)

Just be at the Crest Tavern between 3:00 & 6:00 on-Saturday July 26. All of these folks will be there and you can challenge any one of them for \$5 a shot. Each person has to defend their seat in a best-of-5 501 SI/DO match up to 5 times. It's first come-first serve, so be there early! Oh yeah, one other important point; If you unseat someone, you can be challenged that day too!

Open Qualifying will place 32 men and 32 women in a Double-Elimination Tournament on Sept 6. The top-8 from that will make the team. Don't worry, there's a 2nd-Chance D/E tourney on Sept 14! That will include the 24 men and women who don't make the team via the first D/E, plus the next top-8 of each from the Open Qualifying. The top-8 men and top-4 women from the 2nd-Chance will round out the team of 30 man and 15 women.

The Central Ohio All-Star Dart Team is open to anyone who lives within a 50 mile radius of Columbus. You do not have to be a C.O.D. member to qualify for it.

ADO NEWS

EAST-WEST ALL STAR REGIONALS

Roger Roush will once again carry the torch, representing C.O.D. in the ADO East-West All Star Challenge in Las Vegas on August 15. This makes him only the third man to represent C.O.D. in ADO national level competition.

He earned that spot by finishing as one of the top-6 players in the combined Region IV-1 & IV-4 All Star Regional Playoffs held May 10 in Mentor Ohio. In his preliminary round-robin of 8 Roger finished in 2nd place, winning 15 of 21 games. In the finals of 12, he took 19 of 33 to finish tied for 2nd. That's a total winning percentage of 63%!

Keith Mooney also played in the Regionals. although his game was solid, it just wasn't up to the test that day as he couldn't get past the preliminary round-robin of 8. Perennial All-Star team member-Patty Vickroy from Chillicothe earned her second consecutive trip to Las Vegas by finishing 2nd on the women's side.

CRICKET SINGLES NATIONALS

On May 2, **Deb Lewis** and **Roger Roush** trekked to the northeastern area of our state to play in this event, held in conjunction with the Cleveland Extravaganza. They earned that honor by winning the Region IV-1 playoffs in March.

In the preliminary round-robin of 11 Deb finished 18-12 to garner 3rd place and a spot in the finals. Unfortunately, her game "went south" leaving her in 7th place in the nation in the final round-robin of 8.

Roger saw rough going in the preliminary round—robin of 11. His 18-12 record was good for 4th spot in his group, but only 2 went to the final round-robin.

WINMAU WORLD MASTERS REGIONALS

As City Champions, Caren Holderman and Steve Market will represent C.O.D. at the Regionals for this event on July 12. Wish them "good darts" as they vie for a trip to New York in Sept for the National Finals and a shot at that trip to England.

Oops!, in the April issue, we inadvertently failed to mention that Leah Baltz and Rich Ryan also joined Roger Roush, Deb Lewis and Cindi Leeman at the Cricket Singles Regionals held in March. Leah finished in the 3rd spot, with Rich garnering 4th place.

COORDINATOR'S CORNER:

It's time to start thinking about Fall Season!

What, Summer has barely started, and you want me to think about Fall Season already? Believe it or not, the start of Fall Season is less than 2 months away!-

Your Board and I have been working hard on plans for it. That's right, C.O.D. leagues don't "just happen". A lot of advance planning and work go into making our organization as great as it is.

All of the details and information you need to get your team registered and playing in the Fall Season are contained in this newsletter.

We can't stress enough the importance of Team Captains. That's right, they're important to both you and the organization! Captains are our primary communication mechanism to YOU, our members. A lot of expense goes into mailing them Standing Sheets and other communications during the season. We depend on them to make YOU aware of what's going on.

Does your captain bring the Standing Sheet EVERY WEEK, and SHOW IT TO YOU? At the beginning of the season, does she give you a copy of your team schedule and the ADO Newsletter as well as your yearly membership card and any other important hand-outs? Does he make you aware of things like ADO Qualifiers, Parties, and general things that are going on throughout the year?

Your captain receives a lot of "stuff" during the season, and you have the right to expect that they will share it with you. If they aren't, either get them to do so, or get a new captain.

Captains are more than people who fill out Scorecards. They are responsible for their team, and responsible for getting YOU information that we send to them.

If you're not getting that information, maybe it's time to assign captain responsibilities to someone else!

TEAM SPONSORSHIP

A POSITION STATEMENT Adopted by Board of Directors October 1989

The C.O.D. Board of Directors does not wish to encourage or discourage sponsorship of teams or members playing in its leagues. Sponsorship arrangements should be left solely to the discretion of the parties involved.

However, the Board does feel very strongly that a team or member seeking sponsorship has an obligation to fully explain to the potential sponsor exactly what they are being asked to pay for.

Specifically, this relates to Membership Dues. Since your Dues makes you a member of C.O.D. for the full year (or remaining part), regardless of whether you play during a given league or season, your potential sponsor should be made aware of this fact, if you are asking them to pay your Membership Dues.

The Board hereby goes on record as not endorsing sponsors paying individual Membership Dues as part of a sponsorship arrangement. It feels that individual members should pay their own Dues. At the same time, this does not prohibit sponsors from paying individual Membership Dues if they so wish.

The Board has received comments and complaints that \$225 (5 people Dues & Team Fees) is a lot to pay to sponsor a team. It does not wish to hear such comments/complaints in the future.

Future or continued abuse of your obligation to fully explain to a potential sponsor exactly what they are paying for may result in a sponsorship disclosure statement having to be signed by sponsors. That's just an unnecessary bureaucratic step that none of us want. Let's all be fair and up front with those who sponsor teams!






