Starting this year, both the mens and womens champion will automatically become qualifiers to the A.D.O. All-Star and Masters regionals. They will represent C.O.D. in addition to those players who win the regular local All-Star and Masters qualifiers. This subsidization amounts to a \$200 prize each. 



After graduating from the Ohio State University in June of 1975 with a BFA in Drawing, Painting and Graphics, Ken joined the league because "most of the first members were artists and it looked like it could offer some good contacts to a recent grad. Unfortunately, I didn't find a job in art, but became hooked on darts instead." Life being what it is, however, Ken didn't give up the idea of being gainfully employed just to throw darts and for the past five years he has owned Pfeifer Insurance Agency, representing Nationwide Insurance.

Ken's highest achievements in C.O.D. league play occurred during the 1977 and 1978 seasons when the Accuarts (Ken, Tom Harmon, Trevor Edwards and Jim 'Nogie' Nogawick) were the League Champs for Fall 1977 and Winter 1978. It was during this time that Ken threw his first sanctioned T80.

On the organizational side of things, Ken has done just about everything at one time or another. He is a past Board Member and Banquet Committee Chairman; he has been the tournament director of the Walter Kelley Memorial and Kelley's St. Patrick's Day Tournaments for five years; and he just retired as editor of the DART NEWS after a stint that ran from the July-August 1980 issue to the January-February 1983 issue.

Ken is married to C.O.D. member Gaye Sinclair Pfeifer (two guesses as to how they met) and currently shoots in the G Division on the Midnight Ramblers with Gary Michaels, Jack Glover and Rob Gallant. 
1ST ANNUAL GAVEL CLASSIC




