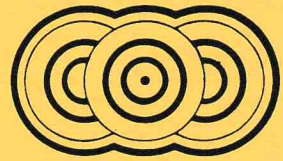


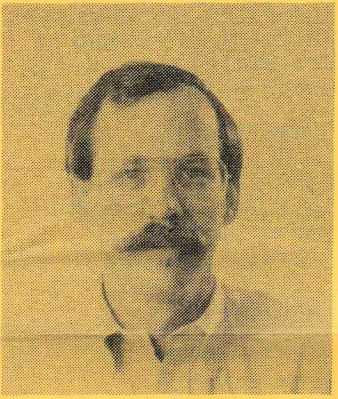

SILVER FLIGHT GOES TO 13 GAME FORMAT

As a result of many requests from the members playing in Silver Flight, the board conducted an experiment last season. The purpose of the experiment was to determine the feasibility of adding 4 singles cricket games to the standard 9 game format of Silver Flight. The experiment was performed in G and H divisions. For four weeks in the middle of the season, all of the teams in G and H divisions played four singles cricket games in addition to their regular games. The results of the additional games were tallied but did not count toward the regular season point total. Surveys were distributed to all players participating in the experiment. The survey results indicated an overwhelming desire to go to the 13 game format. As a result of the experiment, the board has voted to have the Silver Flight begin playing the 13 game format as of Fall Season 1985.

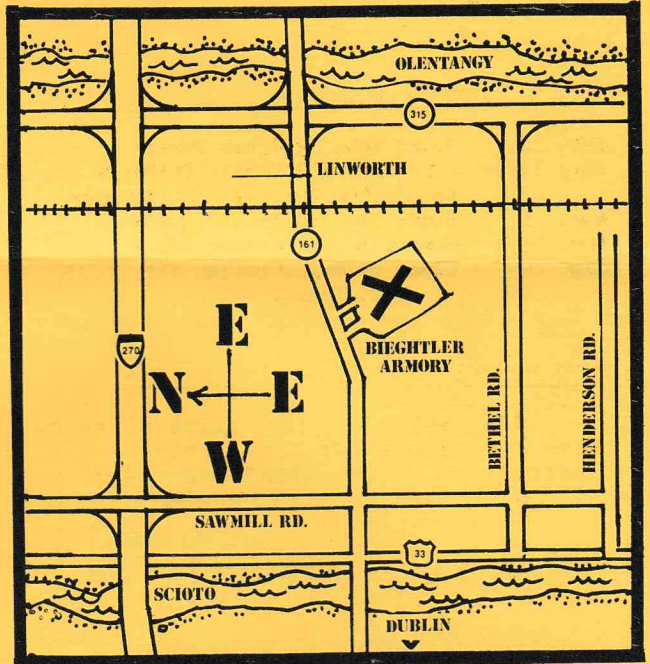

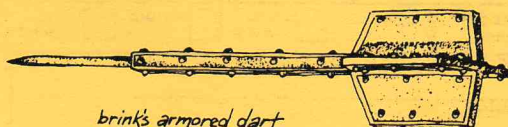

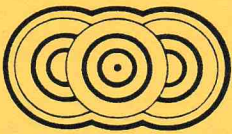

Several COD members travelled to Cincinnati on Saturday, June 8th to represent COD in the ADO all star regional playoffs. Jim Medley, Cindy Bethel, Sharon Tolliver, Brian Uhl and Rob Dixon competed against players from around our region for a chance to advance to the area finals in Atlanta, Georgia in late July.

Brian Uhl and Cindy Bethel won the city championships at the end of the season party to qualify to go. Sharon Tolliver and Jim Medley won the ADO all star qualifiers to advance to the regional playoffs. COD paid for these qualifiers entry fee of \$100 to play. Rob Dixon sponsored himself. Dave Holmes also went to play representing Chillicothe.

The winners of the regional playoffs will advance to the area playoffs in Atlanta, Georgia. The results on Saturday were Tony Payne, Mike Geiger and Peggy Phillips taking 1st place. Expenses are paid by the ADO to the area and national finals. Four men and two women will win to represent the United States in England.

TIPS FOR CHALKERS

Here's a list of the rules of etiquette for both old and new chalkers. Hopefully this will help the players who are new to the game and be a good review for the seasoned Vets. Nobody, but nobody likes a bad chalker and a good chalker is very much appreciated (you may even get a free beer). Just remember these few hints the next time you are asked to chalk a game.

1. Do not talk or move about while keeping score - remain still.
2. Do not look at the shooter - stand facing the scoreboard.
3. Do not lean out to see where a dart is or follow the darts with body or head movements.
4. Do not call out the score of thrown darts, or the remaining score - unless asked.
5. Do not tell a shooter what to shoot, or what combinations to shoot, for an out.
6. Do not show signs of disgust or excitement when chalking - be impartial.
7. Do not change the sides of the scoresheet of the players in 3-leg matches, regardless of diddle. If player or team starts on the left, leave it on the left for all games.

A good chalker is an important part of the match.

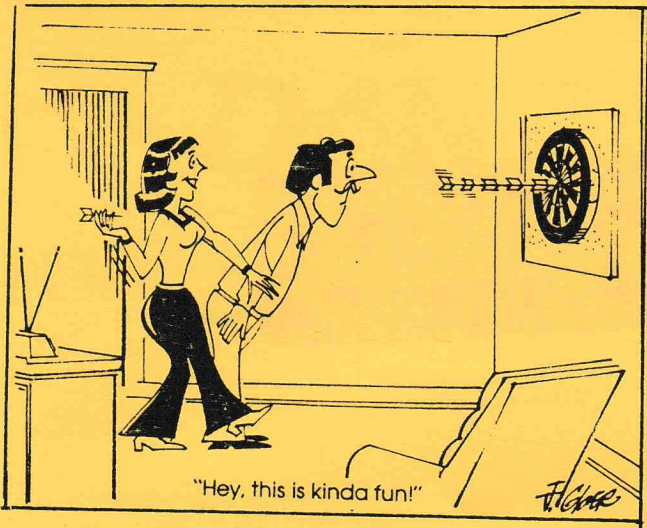

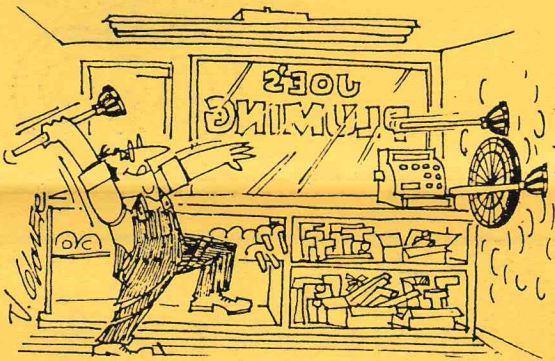
