

FINANCIAL MATTERS

Your Board of Directors has been keeping a careful eve on income and expenses, as well as the reserves we've got in the bank.

We're happy to report that C.O.D.'s financial position is sound and stable, and in good shape for the future. All of our leagues and other activities support themselves as well as the organization as a whole.

Yes, we actually do make a small profit on the Buckeye Open, and are happy to report that this event has never cost any C.O.D. member any paid in money in all of the years of its existence.

Treasurer Bob Houser is custodian of all of the financial records, and will be happy to review them with any members who are interested in all of the facts and figures. All you have to do is ask him.

YOUTH ACTIVITIES

You'll recall that last summer Travis Miller qualified at the Regional level to play in the ADO National Youth Finals, and represented C.O.D. very well. Travis is planning to do the same this year, and C.O.D. is supporting him both in spirit and by paying his Regional Entry Fee. He tells us he's going to win it all this year!

We'd like to offer the same support to any other young players out there.

The ADO youth program has 2 age divisions. Kids 18-20 play at the Regional level to qualify as Junior All-Stars and participate in the East-West All-Star Challenge with a chance to go on to the ADO 501 National Singles Championship.

If you're 7-17, there's a separate division just for you. Just like the older kids, you qualify via Regional Playoffs for the National Youth Finals, and the opportunity to compete in the World Masters Youth Championship in England in December, as well as scholarship money to use to further your education.

If you know of any young people who might like to participate in the Regionals, just let Leah Baltz know who they are and how to contact them.

ELECTIONS

Your Board of Directors is made up of 11 people voted on by the membership. Each person serves a 2-year term.

These are the folks who manage your organization on a day-to-day basis. You have a voice in how your organization operates by way of your membership and consequent right and responsibility to elect them.

If you have a gripe or concern about how your organization is operating you have no one to blame but yourself if you don't vote.

Remember these folks are volunteering to serve you. They have real jobs and real lives outside of darts, just like you.

For the past few years, we've been operating with less than a full 11-member Board. This causes extra work for those serving you, and quite frankly some things just don't get done as a consequence.

YOU CAN CHANGE THAT, and you are the only one who can do it!

At the party on May 21, we'll hold our annual nominations and election of our Board. **YOU** should be there, and **YOU** should vote! It's your right and responsibility as a C.O.D. member!

There will be 7 seats up for election. Four of those are to fill seats being vacated by Leah Baltz, Judy Magruder, Bob Houser and Gary Gollihue who's 2-year terms expire. The other 3 have been empty for almost 2 years.

Continuing on your Board will be John Blosser, Jim Hanck, Doug Heath and Mel Gollihue who each have 1 year left on their terms.

The future of C.O.D. is in your hands!

ADO NEWS

Several of your fellow C.O.D. members are making their darts heard around the country. The AMERICAN DARTS ORGANIZATION Championship Points program rewards players for their participation in tournaments as well as Regional Playoffs during the year.

For 1999, our own **Deb Lewis** ended the year ranked 28th among women across the country, and **Chad Hersman** was 23rd among the men.

Regional Points ranking saw **Leah Baltz** at the top, missing the top-50 women nationally by only 6 points. She was followed by **Deb Lewis** 2nd, **Crystal Poston** 4th **Karen Baron** 8th and **Nan Gehlhar** 9th.

On the men's side, **Chad Hersman** was runnerup to Brad Wethington from Dayton, followed by **Tony Mitchell** 3rd and **Charlie Hummel** in the 10th spot.

In Regional Playoff action, Deb Lewis and Chad Hersman represented us in the Masters Regional heid in March. Unfortunately, their darts weren't up to the task, and they didn't qualify for the National Finals. Both also qualified for the ADO All-Star Regional Playoffs, and will be competing for a free trip to Las Vegas this month.

YOU can take a shot at qualifying for the 2001 ADO World Cup Team this Summer. We'll hold our qualifier on June 7 at 7:00 at the Crest Tavern.

Entry is \$10, and we'll send at least 1 man and 1 woman to the Regional Finals July 28-30. The winners of that will travel to the National Finals in September, which will decide one-half of the ADO World Cup Team for 2001.

The ADO is our national organization, and a member of the World Darts Federation. If you're interested in more information, just check with Leah Baltz, or Charlie Forrester who is the ADO treasurer.
